1. Hold a valid Texas provisional teaching certificate or evidence of equivalent preparation.
2. Have a minimum of two years teaching in a TEA accredited school
3. Complete all coursework in a six (6) year period; earn no less than a "B" in all coursework.
4. File application and successfully defend the Portfolio in last semester of course work.
5. Provide Certificate of Completion of AEL & T-TESS certifications from a RESC or other approved institution

Additional Certification Requirements:

1. Purchase and complete Certify Teacher Principal Test Preparation & Review software
2. Provide Certificate showing completion of 6 hours of study in Certify Teacher Principal Test Preparation or other approved TExES Review
3. Provide Certificate showing and a score of 80% on Certify Teacher Principal Practice Exam
4. Apply for Certification and pay appropriate fees
5. Maintain a Leadership Role on a campus sufficient (as determined by the Educational Leadership Program Coordinator) to allow the student to complete the TExES 368 (PASL)
